The Morgan Conservation District is a special purpose district which was established in 1955 by a vote of the landowners, under the provisions of the Colorado Soil Conservation Act. The district covers most of Morgan County, and parts of Adams and Weld County as well. There are a variety of services which the district provides to the landowners through partnerships with agencies such as the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), Colorado State Conservation Board (CSCB), Colorado Department of Agriculture (CDA), and the Lower South Platte Watershed Association.

Additionally, the district provides educational resources and assistance to the community through workshops, forums, locally led outreach meetings, and events for local school districts.

2019 activities included:

- Educational workshops: bat house workshop with Boy Scouts Troop #22, a Drip Irrigation Tour, and a Pesticide Applicator License Renewal and Noxious Weed Management Workshop
- Wheat Growers Forum
- Earth Day Clean-up with 4H Volunteers
- Outdoor Educational Day at Columbine Elementary School
- Morgan County's Baling Twine Recycling Program
- Annual Conservation Tree Seedling Sale
- Annual College Scholarship

2020 planned activities:

- Co-hosting a Salinity Workshop in January 2020
- Partnering with Green Acres Elementary School to assist with their school garden project
- Partnering with the Fort Morgan Parks Department to install a Boot Brush Kiosk at Riverside Park
- Initiating a multi-county Soilsfest or Waterfest
- Applying for various grants: water quality improvement, pollinator habitat establishment & improvement, beekeeping workshops and cost-share programs, and cost-share for tree sales
- Rehabilitating County windbreaks and living snow fences
- Assisting with the 2020 Safety Day in coordination with Morgan County Extension Office
- Continuation of Morgan County's Baling Twine Recycling Program
